

Middle Dalmatia - Split

Split is unique city, full of surprises, and where you will never get bored. Perhaps Emperor Diocletian, its first citizen, was the one who laid down the firm foundations on which this unusual city with its fast-beating heart and with poetic and sports spirit developed.

What began as an imperial residence and fortified camp is today an intriguing maze of narrow cobblestone streets where pre-Romanesque churches are nestled alongside Gothic chapels. History-filled museums boast galleries of contemporary art and aroma-alluring restaurants compete with bustling cafes for attention of the people that pass them by. The 4th century Diocletian's Palace and city's historical centre were listed on the UNESCO world Heritage list.

Eastern continental Croatia

Osijek lies on the banks of the river Drava, and is the largest city in Slavonia. Life is pulsating all year-round along the length of the longest and surely most beautiful riverside promenade in Croatia.

Situated in the centre of fertile Slavonian valley, Osijek is rich with beautiful ethnological, cultural and culinary secrets and customs. They are hidden, nurtured by the people of Slavonia for centuries, passed on from generation to generation.

Citadel is the Old Town of Osijek. It is the best-preserved and largest ensemble of Baroque buildings in Croatia and consists of a Habsburg start fort built on the right bank of the river Drava. Citadel (Tvrđa) has been described by the World Monuments Fund as "a unique example of an eighteenth-century baroque military, administrative, and commercial urban center".
