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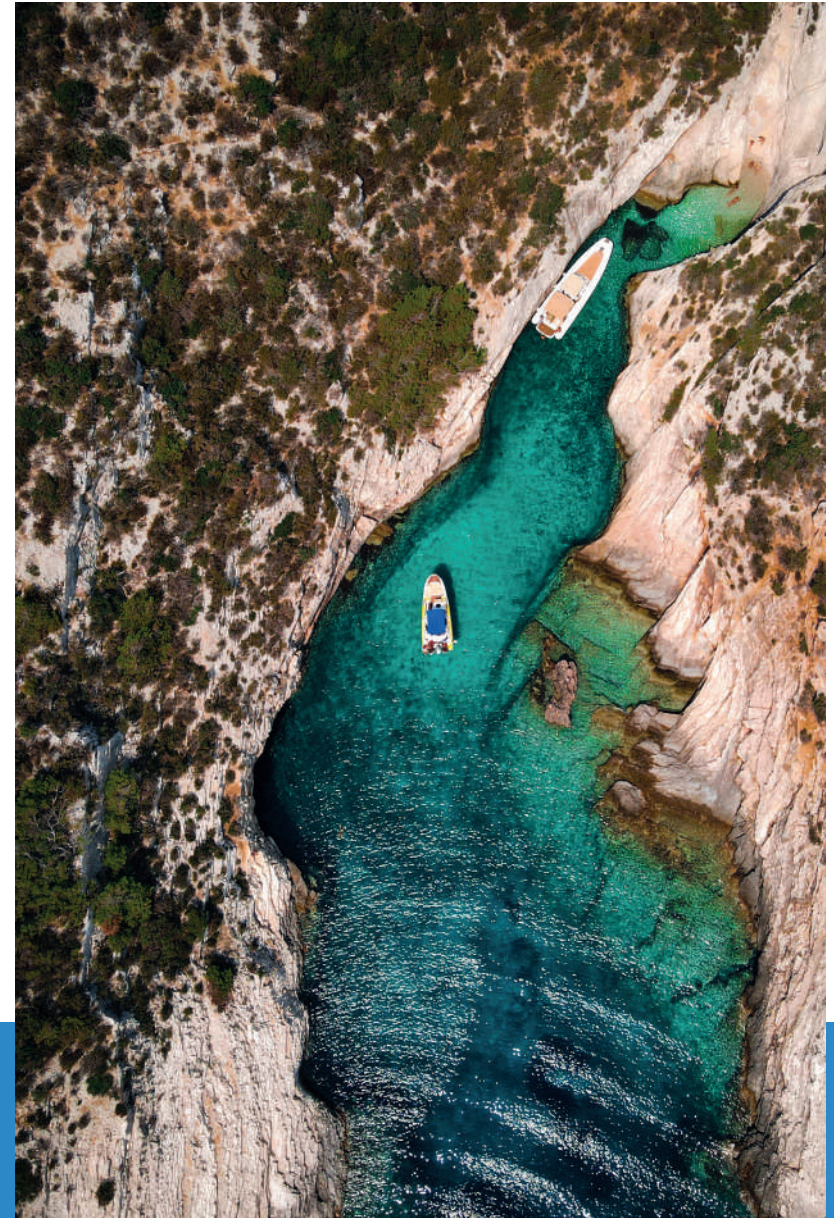

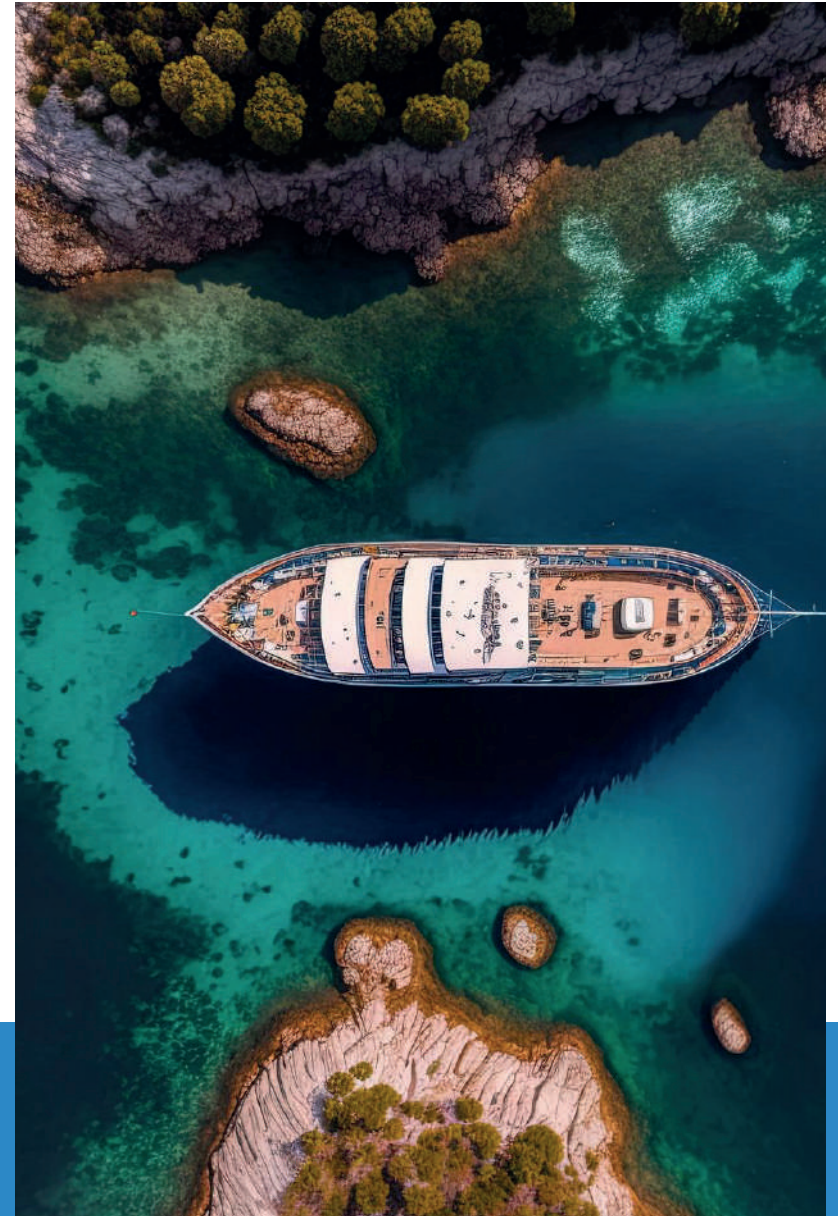

9 days / 8 nights



DAY 1. ZAGREB

Welcome to Croatia! Your transfer will await you upon your arrival at Croatia's capital city. Depending on your flight arrival, we leave you to rest or explore the city to take in first impressions. Welcome dinner in the hotel.

DAY 2. ZAGREB

After breakfast enjoy sightseeing tour of the capital and the largest city of Croatia. Walk around the historical city centre and explore major sights and rich history dating from Roman times. Feel unique experience of everyday Zagreb on Dolac, open-air farmers market where locals buy food for past 80 years, meet the locals and taste fresh seasonal products from Zagreb surroundings. On the way to the upper city you will pass the famous Stone gate, one of the best-preserved monuments of the old Zagreb and hear its story. Take a ride with the funicular in Zagreb and a walk via Lenuzzi green horseshoe – one of the major urban interventions in the history of Croatian architecture and horticulture. Afterwards, enjoy traditional meal of the area in local restaurant. End this day with afternoon at leisure or join our optional half-day excursion to delightful town of Varazdin – the city of music, baroque and flowers. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 3. ZAGREB - NP PLITVICE - ZADAR (270 KM)

Today travel from Zagreb to UNESCO city of Zadar. On the way we shall stop at National Park Plitvice lakes, a masterpiece of nature. Through centuries water was carving lakes and forming waterfalls resulting with creation of 16 crystal clear lakes. It is the first and the biggest National park in Croatia and the only one put on UNESCO list of natural heritage in 1979. Once we arrive at National park Plitvice lakes, considering weather conditions we will choose the best route between many that are possible. We will hike, cross the biggest lake with the boat and drive with the panoramic bus. Before continuing to Zadar city, enjoy traditional meal in local restaurant in Plitvice area. Arrival to Zadar for a one night stay.

DAY 4. ZADAR - ŠIBENIK - SPLIT (170 KM)

Morning sightseeing tour of UNESCO Zadar. Visit the beautiful old roman forum, listen to the sea organs and discover why Zadar is a unique town along Croatia's Dalmatian coast, where travellers come to enjoy the seafood and watch dreamy sunsets. Our tour takes us forward to special experience of wine tasting in the garden setting of one of the Croatia's leading winemakers located in the hills of Skradin. Wine production in Croatia goes way back to Ancient Greek times so many traditional local grape varieties survived in Croatia, enjoy the taste! Next destination we will not miss on our way to Split, driving along the scenic coastline is beautiful UNESCO city of Šibenik, hear how it successfully combines its famous past and the gift of natural beauties. Enjoy a beautiful three nights stay at the second largest city of Croatia.

DAY 5. SPLIT & TROGIR (75 KM)

Morning sightseeing tour of Split. Walk through the medieval streets as the Romans did 18 centuries ago and enjoy impressive sites such as the palace of the great emperor Diocletian with his mausoleum – today's cathedral, Peristyle, Golden gate, various statues, Venetian palaces and more. Spend some free time exploring Riva-Split's beautiful waterside promenade lined with restaurants, shops and cafes. Following historic footsteps second destination of the day is Trogir, the oldest city on the Adriatic coast under UNESCO protected sites. Reveal the unique memorial heritage and adore the beautiful masterpieces of famous sculptors – the magnificent Cathedral's portal of master Radovan and the reliefs of master Niccolò di Giovanni Fiorentino. Return to Split for dinner and overnight.



DAY 6. SPLIT - BRAC ISLAND TOUR (75 KM)

Enjoy unforgettable experience on a day trip to Brač island the third largest island in the Adriatic. During this full-day excursion you will visit the oldest settlement on the island, village Škrip, a home to the Museum of the Island of Brač and Oil Museum. Afterwards we continue to the highest point of all Croatian islands – Vidova Gora (778 meters above sea level) where you can enjoy the spectacular view of Bol and the other neighboring islands Hvar, Korčula and Vis. We will end the trip with a visit to small pastoral settlement of stone houses and cattle hens, located in the original environment of the Brač shepard's settlements, on Vidova Gora. On a small farm you will find sheeps, goats, pigs, geese, horses and donkeys and enjoy traditional food made from locally produced ingredients. Return to Split for overnight.

DAY 7. SPLIT - STON - DUBROVNIK (240 KM)

Today we leave Split travelling along the coast towards a true pearl of Croatia – Dubrovnik.

We will stop in Ston, small fisherman town and once very important salt producing centre strategically positioned on the Adriatic shore along important trade routes. Ston is also a popular destination for foodies due to the local Mali Ston Bay rich with mussels and oysters, a culinary highlight of any foodie tour in Croatia which you will taste today in unique gastronomic attraction by sailing a boat experiencing untouched natural beauty of the protected eco system. Upon arrival to Dubrovnik enjoy sightseeing tour in the afternoon. The walls of Dubrovnik girdle a perfectly preserved complex of public and private, sacral and secular buildings representing all periods of the city's history, beginning with its founding in the 7th century. Walk through city's main street Stradun and learn of the Rector's Palace, the church of St. Blaise, the Cathedral, three large monasteries and the City Hall. The Republic of Dubrovnik was the centre of a separate political and territorial entity, and was proud of its culture, its achievements in commerce and especially of its freedom preserved down so many tempestuous centuries.

DAY 8. DUBROVNIK

Today enjoy day at leisure or join us on optional full day excursion to island of Korčula.

Departure transfer to Dubrovnik airport.

DAY 1. ZAGREB

Upon arrival, individual or group transfer to Zagreb hotel. Welcome drink and get together at the hotel. Dinner in hotel in Zagreb.

DAY 2. ZAGREB

After breakfast enjoy sightseeing tour of the capital and the largest city of Croatia. Walk around the historical city centre and explore major sights and rich history dating from Roman times. Afterwards, enjoy traditional meal of the area in local restaurant. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 3. ZAGREB - LJUBLJANA (143 KM)

After breakfast your transfer will drive you to Slovenia. Once we arrive we will settle and refresh ourselves in the hotel. Afternoon we will enjoy in our walking tour. We will discover Ljubljana - the city grew around the Grand Fortress, built in the twelfth century at the top of a hill from where one can enjoy a splendid view of the Julian Alps and Karavanke. Enjoy Ljubljana Castle, The Square of Three Bridges, National Museum and Opera House during a nice walk. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Ljubljana.

DAY 4. BLEED (53 KM)

After breakfast your transfer will take you to Bled. Bled is a great natural beauty, surrounded by the Alps. It is well known for its lake, hot springs and mild climate. It has an island considered to be the most beautiful in the world, with an eleventh century castle. Visit the picture-perfect Castle on the hill. From the castle you can see a small, verdant island in the middle of the lake – home to the white tower and red roof of the Baroque style Church of the Virgin's Nativity. We will take a gondola ride to the island and climb the monumental staircase which leads to the famous „Bell of Wishes “. After excursion lunch will be served in local restaurant. Overnight in Ljubljana.

DAY 5. LJUBLJANA - PLITVICE (250 KM)

After breakfast we leave Ljubljana towards Plitvice. Upon arrival, enjoy guided walking tour of beautiful natural lake complex Plitvice, listed on UNESCO's List of World Natural Heritage. Hike between lakes, beneath waterfalls and admire always changing colours of water. Over one million people every year stop in the Lika region just to be able to enjoy this masterpiece of nature. Through centuries water was carving lakes and forming waterfalls resulting with creation of 16 crystal clear lakes. It is first and the biggest National park in Croatia. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Plitvice.

DAY 6. PLITVICE - ZADAR - SPLIT (280 KM)

After breakfast we are heading towards Split. On our way to Split we will have a stop in Zadar, where we will explore city during our walking tour. We will pass by the St Donatus' Church which is the most important preserved structure of its period in Dalmatia. Beside the historical centre discover one of the first musical pipe organs that are played by the sea so called – Zadar's Sea Organs and the famous site called the Greeting to the sun. After free time in Zadar we are continuing to Split. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Split.

DAY 7. SPLIT - STON - DUBROVNIK (230 KM)

After breakfast we will discover UNESCO protected monument Diocletian's palace in the Historical nucleus of Split. Enjoy the most impressive sites such as Peristyle, Golden gate, various statues, Venetian palaces and much more. Spend some free time exploring Riva - Split's beautiful waterside promenade lined with restaurants, shops and cafes. Once our walking tour finishes we are continuing to Dubrovnik. On our way we will have stop for lunch in Ston - town with the longest fortifications in Europe, a defence wall 3.4 miles long. The walls are still standing today, and so is the salt production in Ston town which is an otherwise popular destination for foodies due to the local Mali Ston Bay mussels and oysters. Overnight at hotel in Dubrovnik.



DAY 8. DUBROVNIK

After breakfast we will have Dubrovnik walking tour. Magnificent old city known for its characteristic red roofs and old roman streets. Dubrovnik (Ragusa) is one of the most important historical and tourist centres which was also in 1979 included in UNESCO's World Heritage List. Except for its cultural and historical sites, Dubrovnik is inexhaustible source of traditionally prepared food, excellent selections of vine and great choice of café and souvenir shops. Lunch will be served in local restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 9. DUBROVNIK - MONTENEGRO - DUBROVNIK (200 KM)

After breakfast we will have full day excursion to Montenegro. Budva the Old Town lies on a little island that was linked to the land by a sandbar and in time turned into a peninsula. We continue our excursion to UNESCO Kotor, - edieval architecture and numerous monuments of cultural heritage have made Kotor a UNESCO listed "World Natural and Historical Heritage Site". Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 10. DUBROVNIK - MOSTAR - SARAJEVO (250 KM)

After breakfast departure for Sarajevo. On our way we will have walking tour of UNESCO Mostar. During your sightseeing you will witness the imprint left by this varied history and enjoy fairy tale book like scenery. We continue to Stari most (Old bridge), which is one of the country's most recognizable landmarks and a fantastic piece of Islamic architecture in the Balkan region. During your sightseeing of Mostar you will also visit Old Bazaar, typical Turkish house and other attractions. Continue to Sarajevo. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Sarajevo.

DAY 11. SARAJEVO - BELGRADE (306 KM)

After breakfast we will have sightseeing of Sarajevo. Sarajevo is a city where over four hundred years mosques, synagogues, orthodox and Roman Catholic churches have been built and have stood side by side here. After tour we are heading to Belgrade. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Belgrade.

DAY 12. BELGRADE

After breakfast full day sightseeing of Belgrade, the capital of Serbia. On foot we will visit the biggest park in Belgrade – Kalemegdan and the Kalemegdan fortress. Proceed by bus in the direction of Terazije, Parliament, City Hall, Pioneer Park, towards Slavija square. Then we will walk through park of Karađorđe until the Temple of Saint Sava (largest of its kind in the world). Dinner will be served at local restaurant in old town. Overnight at hotel in Belgrade.

DAY 13. BELGRADE - ZAGREB (400 KM)

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Zagreb airport for your departing flight.

FROM VENICE TO DUBROVNIK

12 days / 11 nights

DAY 1. VENICE - POREC (245 KM)

Venice, one of the most romantic cities in the world. Join Venice sightseeing with your local guide and admire its hidden treasures nestled amid its squares, bridges and narrow streets. After sightseeing travel via Trieste to Poreč, for a 3 night stay.

DAY 2. POREC

After breakfast enjoy in HD included sightseeing of Poreč, well known for the UNESCO protected Euphrasia Basilica, rebuilt in the 6th century during the Byzantine Empire. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure or join a HD Optional Excursion to Rovinj.

DAY 3. POREC - PULA - POREC

After breakfast, enjoy day at leisure or 3/4 D Optional Excursion to Pula.

DAY 4. POREC - OPATIJA (91 KM)

Travel from Poreč via Istrian peninsula and Učka tunnel to the city of Opatija, for a 2 nights stay.

DAY 5. OPATIJA

Enjoy an included HD excursion to Opatija, one of the most famous tourist destinations on the eastern coast of the Adriatic for more than 150 years. In the afternoon you can perhaps join an Optional HD excursion to Lovran and Mošćenica.

DAY 6. OPATIJA - SPLIT (399 KM)

Travel along the scenic coast from Opatija to Split. Expert local guides will show you the city highlights of Zadar and Šibenik. After included Lunch in Zadar and free time continue to Šibenik where you will visit the UNESCO protected St. Jacob church. On arrival in Split check in for 3 nights stay.

DAY 7. SPLIT - SALONA - SPLIT

A local guide will show you this morning the ancient town of Split, Croatia's second largest city. Split is known for Diocletian palace, built by Roman Empire more than 1700 years ago. Today it is an UNESCO World Heritage Site, which is still home to more than 3,000 people. Afternoon at leisure or join a HD Optional excursion to Salona birth place of Emperor Diocletian.

DAY 8. SPLIT - TROGIR - SPLIT

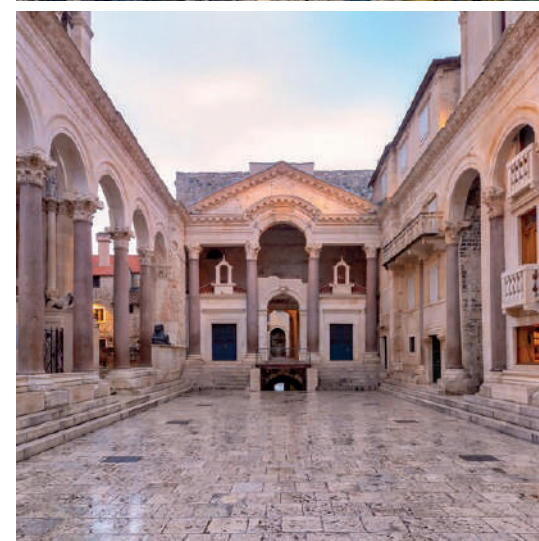
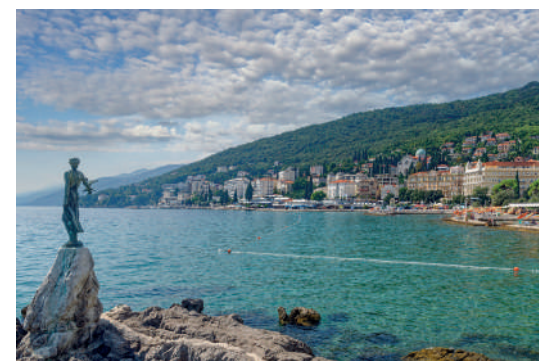
Perhaps join a HD Optional Excursion to UNESCO Trogir – the town museum in the very meaning of the word. Lovers of cultural and historical monuments, art, original architecture and nice alleys are given the opportunity in Trogir to learn about the manifold and complex heritage from the Romanesque yard to the modern interiors.

DAY 9. SPLIT - NERETVA - DUBROVNIK (235 KM)

After breakfast, drive along the coast to the pearl of Croatia – Dubrovnik for a 3 night stay. Stop on rout on your way to Dubrovnik for lunch at River Norin, known for its beautiful landscapes.

DAY 10. DUBROVNIK

Sightseeing of Dubrovnik, UNESCO World Heritage site since 1979. Enjoy the wonderful city highlights such as the City walls, Rectors palace, St. Blaise and the Cathedral Church, Onofrio's Fountain and much more. In the afternoon you can join a HD Optional excursion to Konavle Valley surrounded by cypress, laurel and pine trees.

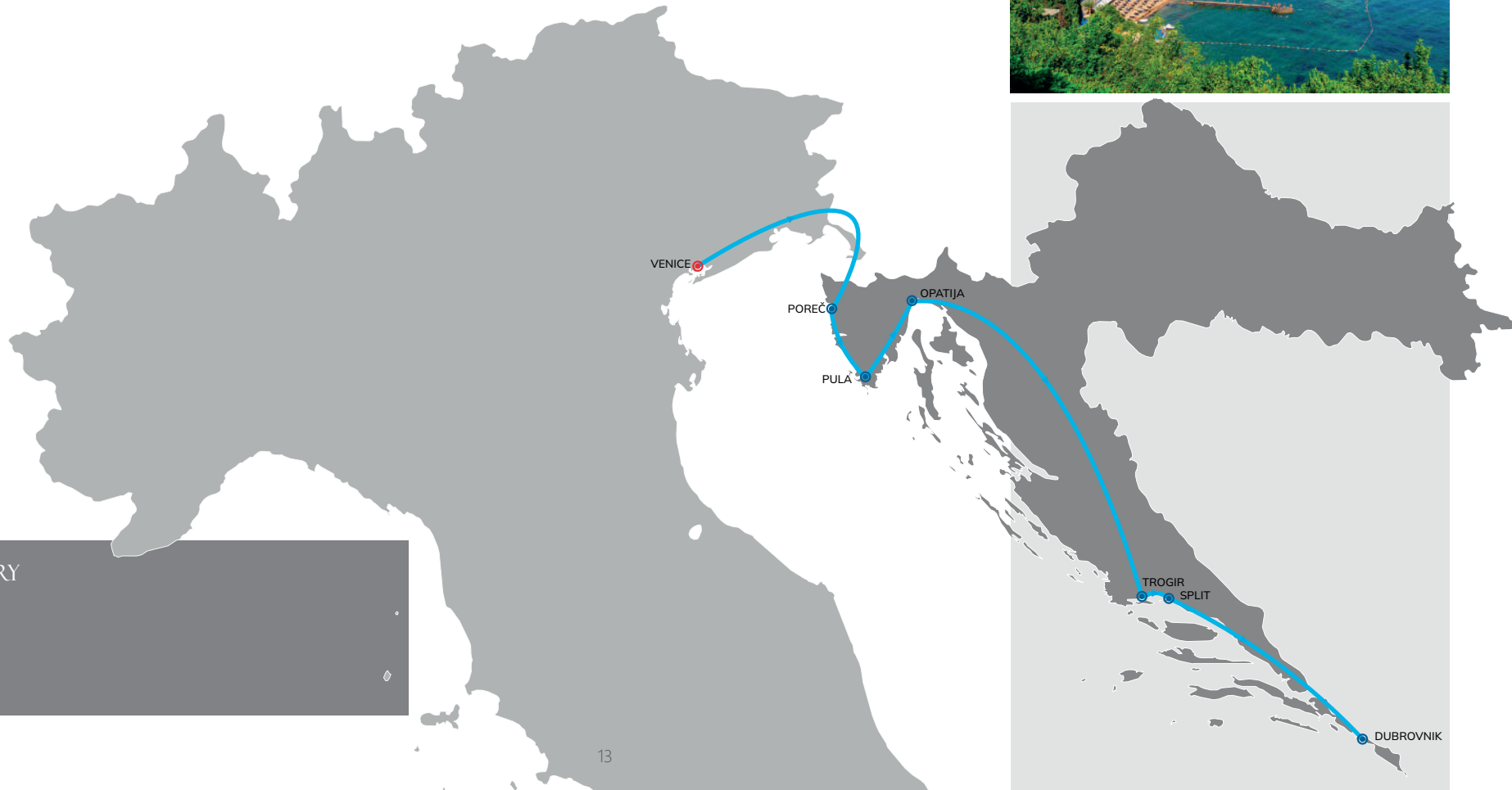


DAY 11. DUBROVNIK - KOTOR - BUDVA - DUBROVNIK

Spend your day at leisure or join a FD excursion to Montenegro (Kotor and Budva). Feast your eyes on the spectacular fjords of Montenegro on this day-long trip. Stop in historic Kotor, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Visit the cathedral of St Tryphon from the 12th century. Enjoy an included snack in Budva as well as a guided sightseeing tour of the old town dating from the 15th century, nestled amid its squares, bridges and narrow streets. After sightseeing travel via Trieste to Poreč, for a 3 night stay.

DAY 12. DEPARTURE (22 KM)

After breakfast, organized transfer will take you to the Dubrovnik Airport.

FIVE COUNTRIES REVEAL

11 days / 10 nights

DAY 1. DUBROVNIK (22 KM)

Arrival in Dubrovnik, dinner and overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 2. DUBROVNIK - CETINJE (124 KM)

Morning, join a HD sightseeing of Dubrovnik. The walls of Dubrovnik girdle a perfectly preserved complex of public and private, sacral and secular buildings representing all periods of the city's history, beginning with its founding in the 7th century. Particular mention should be made of the city's main street, Stradun, the Rector's Palace, the church of St. Vlaho, the Cathedral, three large monasteries and the City Hall. In the afternoon departure for Cetinje. Upon arrival visit of town with two of the most representative buildings: The Monasteries of Cetinje and Biljarda. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Cetinje.

DAY 3. CETINJE - BUDVA - TIRANA (200 KM)

Departure for Budva and Saint Stefan. Apart from being famous for nearby St. Stefan's Island, the Old town of Budva, which lies on a small peninsula, is known as a treasure chest of culture heritage with its narrow streets and squares are famous buildings and churches. In the afternoon proceed for Tirana, the capital of Albania. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Tirana.

DAY 4. TIRANA - OHRID (130 KM)

Morning sightseeing of Tirana - Albania's capital since 1920. The city tour of Tirana begins at Skenderberg Square, a great open space in the heart of the city. The most of sights are situated near by Main Square, such as National History Museum, Mausoleum of former President Enver Hoxha, Palace of Culture, and the Mosque Et'hem Bey, Clock tower. Afternoon departure for Ohrid, lake on border with Macedonia. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Ohrid.

DAY 5. OHRID

Morning HD sightseeing of Ohrid. Rightfully referred to as "The Jerusalem of the Balkans", Ohrid abounds in churches, the walls of which are decorated with wonderful frescoes dating back from early 11th century.

DAY 6. OHRID - SKOPJE (173 KM)

Morning departure for Skopje. In the afternoon, the sightseeing of Skopje. The capital of Macedonia is divided by Vardar river on two parts: Slavic and Ottoman. Visit The Stone bridge, Daut-Pashin hamam (Turkish bath), Feudal tower, Isa - Bey's mosque, Mustafa - Pasha mosque, Old Skopje bazaar (market place), fortress Skopsko Kale, St. Nikita Monastery, St. Spas church. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Skopje.

DAY 7. SKOPJE - VRANJACKA BANJA (306 KM)

After breakfast, departure to Vrnjačka Banja, famous Serbian spa and highly developed tourist destination. On the way to Vrnjačka Banja visit of Monastery Žiča (founded by the Serbian King Stefan "the First-Crowned" at the beginning of the 13th century), and Studenica (founded by Stefan Nemanja, who took monastic orders there choosing the name Simeon) which is considered to be the crowning achievement of mediaeval culture and art in Serbia. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Vrnjačka Banja.

DAY 8. VRANJAČKA BANJA - KRUŠEVAC - BELGRADE (200 KM)

Travel to Kruševac. Kruševac was founded in late 14th century as the capital city of Prince Lazar's Serbia, and soon became its military, cultural and economical centre. Visit to Monastery Ljubostina on the way to Kruševac. After visit of Kruševac, afternoon departure to Beograd, the capital of Serbia. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Belgrade.



DAY 9. BELGRADE

Morning HD sightseeing of Belgrade. The Capital of Serbia is situated on the mouth of river Sava into Danube. We visit various city quarters, including New Belgrade on the left bank of the Sava River, the luxurious residential area of Dedinje and the picturesque Old town. A highlight of the tour is our brief visit to the archaeological and historical site of Belgrade Fortress. Situated at Kalemegdan, the remains of the old city's fortify captions from the 1st to the 18th centuries overlook a spectacular panoramic view of the Sava and Danube confluence. Afternoon free for leisure. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Belgrade.

DAY 10. BELGRADE - SARAJEVO (294 KM)

Continue through Pannonia lowland to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Drive through Drina river valley to cross the border of Bosnia and Herzegovina. City with many diversities, which shows a unique link between the East and the West. Visit to Baščaršija, oriental Svrvzina house and Princip Bridge. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 11. SARAJEVO - MOSTAR - DUBROVNIK (236 KM)

On the way to Dubrovnik, drive through beautiful Neretva Valley and visit Mostar. Situated between Sarajevo and Dubrovnik, Mostar is the main centre of Herzegovina and was founded by the Turks in the 15th century. During sightseeing explore the UNESCO protected Old town, once the centre of the city's Islamic culture and visit Mostar's famous 14th century Bridge. Continue to Dubrovnik, dinner and overnight at the hotel.

ADRIATIC JEWELS

5 days / 4 nights

DAY 1. DUBROVNIK

Arrival in Dubrovnik, transfer from the airport to your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 2. DUBROVNIK - SPLIT (235 KM)

After breakfast, a guided stroll around the Old City visiting the Franciscan Monastery, Rector's Palace and the Cathedral. You'll also have some time to explore the City on your own after which we head towards Split. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 3. SPLIT - TROGIR - ZADAR (160 KM)

Morning guided tour of Split. Located in the centre of the Dalmatian coast and nestled between the mountains and the sea, Split is a picturesque ancient town built by the Roman Emperor Diocletian. Visit the impressive emperor's palace built in the 3rd century, Peristyle and the Cathedral. The journey then takes us to Trogir, a charming stone town under the protection of UNESCO, which takes pride in the fascinating Romanesque cathedral, churches and beautiful palaces. After the short sightseeing of this Dalmatian pearl we continue on towards Zadar. Arrival at the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 4. ZADAR - ZAGREB (285 KM)

Breakfast. After the short city tour, we head towards Zagreb, the capital of Croatia. After the check-in, city tour of Zagreb including the Upper Town, historical centre of the city, Church of St. Mark with the famed multicoloured roof, Cathedral, Croatian National Theatre and University. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

DAY 5. DEPARTURE

After breakfast, transfer to the Zagreb airport.

BIKE THROUGH DALMATIAN COAST

7 days / 6 nights

DAY 1. SPLIT (25 KM)

Arrival transfer to our hotel in Split. Overnight Split.

DAY 2. MORNING BIKE TOUR IN SPLIT (BIKING 10 KM)

After breakfast, we will start our bike tour next to the famous green market towards the famous Split promenade continuing to the relaxing surrounding of Marjan hill. The final part of the tour takes you through an old neighborhood called "Varos". Here, you will be able to feel the real charm of Mediterranean living. Cycling back to the busy town center.

DAY 3. HVAR BIKE TOUR (BIKING 30 KM)

Catamaran transfer to Island Hvar and after checking into hotel, transfer to Stari Grad. Our bike tour starts by cycling from Stari Grad through the Stari Grad Plain to Vrboska. After driving along the coast to Jelsa, we will stop for a tasting with top quality wine and olive oil. On the way back, enjoy a traditional lunch of organic food and wine locally produced. Cycling back to Stari grad. Transfer back to hotel.

DAY 4. HVAR - KORČULA AND AFTERNOON LUMBARDA BIKING (20 KM)

Breakfast and morning catamaran to Korčula. After settling in the hotel, we will enjoy an afternoon bike tour. We will cycle through the eastern side of the island to reach the village of Lumbarda. Our first stop is at a local family winery where we will have a wine and food tasting, after which you can go to refresh and rest on one of the Lombardy beaches. Our tour ends with a return to the town of Korčula.

DAY 5. KORČULA BIKE TOUR (25 KM)

From the town of Korčula we will start cycling to get to the village of Zrnovo, one of the oldest settlements on the island. After a short break we continue onto a gravel road that leads us to magical place - the labyrinth of strangely shaped dolomite rocks dressed in moss, overgrown with ivy, surrounded by holm oak and fern. On the way back we return to Zrnovo to enjoy organic products and food of the area in an original old stone house. To broaden the perspective of this beautiful part of the island, we return to Korčula by another route.

DAY 6. KORČULA - STON - DUBROVNIK EVENING STROLLING THROUGH STREETS BY BIKE (BIKING 15 KM)

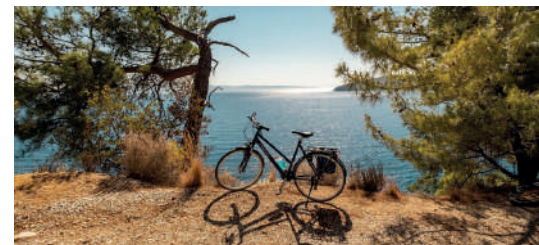
Transfer to Dubrovnik with stop in Ston. Lunch in Ston is a culinary highlight of any foodie tour in Croatia - unique gastronomic experience by sailing a boat among untouched natural beauty of the protected eco system of the bay. After settling in the hotel, we'll ride to city centre and then continue to the coast of Lapad. Our tour then continues along the seaside, all around the peninsula of Lapad. We will climb to Petka, the only fully green hill in the entire Dubrovnik. Our itinerary will then take us to Gorica and from there, we'll proceed to Boninovo, a neighbourhood whose great sea views stretch uninterrupted all the way to Italy. Here we'll have a photo-stop and then ride back.

DAY 7. DEPARTURE DUBROVNIK (22 KM)

Enjoy the breakfast and when you are ready, start your journey home.

WINE TOUR CROATIA & SLOVENIA

7 days / 6 nights



DAY 1. ZAGREB - ROVINJ (250 KM)
Arrival to Zagreb and transfer to Rovinj. Overnight.

DAY 2. ISTRIA'S HILLTOP TOWNS
Visit the idyllic hilltop towns of Bale, Vodnjan, Motovun, Beram, Pazin, Grožnjan, Livade, and Buzet. Learn about the rich history of each town while you wander among ancient Roman ruins, Gothic churches, and Baroque-style villas. Be charmed with the medieval towers and pretty squares that are filled with tiny cafes, restaurants and galleries. Visit the wine cellars and a small wine museum. Stroll through endless vineyards on fertile soil which makes the Istrian region famous for grape cultivation.

DAY 3. TRUFFLE HUNTING AND WINERY VISIT IN ISTRIA
Enjoy the best of Istria's rich culinary history on a truffle hunt at the Motovun forest, under the guidance of a professional truffle hunter with specially trained dogs. Next, head over to the small village of Livade where the largest truffle was found. Continue your journey to the winery in the village of Momjan owned by the Markezic family. Visit the wine cellars and a small wine museum.

DAY 4. ROVINJ - POSTOJNA CAVE - BLED (235 KM)
Discover the magical underground world of Postojna Cave. Hop on the underground electrical train for a ride of a lifetime through 14 miles of stunning ice formations developed across centuries. Witness the steady dripping of water along the dazzling white curves of the stalagmite called 'Brilliant'. Take a tour of the largest inside a cave system where live performances are held regularly.

DAY 5. LIPIZZA HORSES, CHURCH OF THE HOLY TRINITY HRASTOVLJE, STANJEL VILLAGE AND WINE TASTING IN KRAS
Kras is one of the most unique regions of Slovenia, where nature and culture co-exist in unique synergy connected with the Karst landscape. From there emerged Karst Lipizzaners. We will visit the home of this breed and tour the stables. The area is littered with wine cellars, that are producing a wide variety of wines. During the scenic drive towards the fortified town of Stanjel, we will stop in one of the local wine cellars and do the wine tasting. At the end of the day, stop in the unique church of the Holy Trinity will follow.

DAY 6. TRIP AROUND 2 GREAT SLOVENIAN WINE REGIONS GORIŠKA BRDA & VIPAVA VALLEY
Explore two wine-growing districts of Primorska region in one day: Vipava Valley and Goriška Brda. This is the only area in Slovenia with the dominant influence of the Mediterranean climate, which affects local wines, cuisine and people. Meet the local winemakers and learn about what influenced their way of the wine production.

DAY 7. DEPARTURE LJUBLJANA (55 KM)
Departure transfer to Ljubljana airport.

9 days / 8 nights



- DAY 1. SPLIT (25 KM)**
Arrival to Split and transfer to hotel. Overnight.
- DAY 2. SPLIT - BRAC ISLAND (B)**
Discover UNESCO protected monument Diocletian's palace in the Historical nucleus of Split and enjoy impressive sites such as cathedral, Peristyle, Golden gate, various statues, Venetian palaces and much more. Spend some free time exploring Riva. Overnight on Brac.
- DAY 3. BRAC ISLAND (B)**
During Brac Island tour you will visit Skrip, the oldest settlement on the island, including museum of island Brac and Olive Oil Museum. Admire Vidova Gora, highest peak on Dalmatian islands. Dinner in local "konoba", with traditional "peka" meal. Overnight on Brac.
- DAY 4. BRAC ISLAND - HVAR ISLAND (B)**
Enjoy free morning in town of Bol and on the famous Zlatni Rat beach known as the "Golden Horn", reputed to be the most beautiful in the Adriatic. Ferry from Brac to Hvar. Hvar is an island with more sun than any other in all Europe. Welcome. Overnight on Hvar.
- DAY 5. HVAR ISLAND (B)**
Explore Hvar, ancient town with a rich history and unique cultural and historical heritage. You will drive among amazing lavender fields and visit small villages on your way to lunch location. Visit 2400 years old Stari grad, which is under UNESCO protection. You will have time to try unique gastronomy that island has to offer. After lunch, you will be transfer to your hotel. Overnight on Hvar.
- DAY 6. HVAR ISLAND - KORCULA ISLAND (B)**
Ferry from Hvar to Korcula. The island of Korcula belongs to the central Dalmatian archipelago. You will have free afternoon to soak up the town. Overnight in Korcula.
- DAY 7. KORCULA ISLAND (B)**
Explore the Old Town of Korcula, which is still surrounded by its 13th-century fortifications, built by the Venetians. Korcula boasts one of the most beautiful old towns in Dalmatia and because of its fortress-like appearance it is often called "Little Dubrovnik". Overnight in Korcula.
- DAY 8. KORCULA ISLAND - DUBROVNIK (B)**
Ferry from Korcula to Dubrovnik. Enjoy a city tour of Dubrovnik, the Pearl of Adriatic which is a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1979. Overnight in Dubrovnik.
- DAY 9. DEPARTURE (B) (22 KM)**
Transfer from hotel to Dubrovnik Airport.

DAY 1. UNESCO TROGIR - UNESCO SPLIT

Boarding time in the port of Trogir is from 12:00 am to 2:00 pm. Upon arrival, our staff will welcome you and will take your luggage to the port. After embarkation, welcome drink will be served. After a lunch we stop in one of the bays on the island of Čiovo, where we will have our first chance to dip into the crystal-clear water of the Adriatic Sea. After having enjoyed swimming and sunbathing, we will set sail for UNESCO Split. Split is Croatia's second largest city and the capital of Dalmatia. Walk through the medieval streets as the Romans did 18 centuries ago and enjoy the most impressive sites such as the palace of the great emperor Diocletian with his mausoleum – today's cathedral, Peristyle, Golden gate, various statues, Venetian palaces and much more. Afterwards spend some free time exploring Riva – beautiful waterside promenade lined with restaurants, shops and cafes. Overnight in the port of Split.

DAY 2. UNESCO SPLIT - HVAR ISLAND

Today we will be sailing to the island of Hvar known for its mild climate and fragrant lavender fields. On our way to Hvar, we will stop in a secluded bay for a swim. After having reached Hvar, we will anchor in the port of Hvar, the capital of the island. The town of Hvar is the centre of the island's tourism, one of the favourite destinations in Croatia and one of the most prominent and visited tourist centres in the whole Adriatic Sea. Hvar is the town with rich cultural and historical heritage such as: the fortress, the Cathedral of St. Stephan, the Franciscan monastery, town loggia, the Hektorovic Palace, the arsenal and the theatre. Overnight in the port of Hvar.

DAY 3. HVAR ISLAND - NATIONAL PARK MLJET

Sailing along the south coast of the island of Korčula, we will stop at one of the numerous bays for a swim, before heading to our next port of call – Pomena, on the island of Mljet. Part of the island was declared a National Park – two saltwater lakes are connected to the sea by a narrow channel. They originated approximately 10,000 years ago. Until the Christian era, they were freshwater lakes, but since then a narrow passage, Soline bay, has connected them to the sea. Overnight in Pomena.

DAY 4. NATIONAL PARK MLJET - UNESCO DUBROVNIK

We continue our journey south. After a swimming break at the Elafiti Islands, we will enter the port of Dubrovnik around 4:00 pm. Dubrovnik a magnificent old city known for its characteristic red roofs and old roman streets also called the "Pearl of the Adriatic". Dubrovnik is one of the most important historical and tourist centres which was also in 1979 included in UNESCO's World Heritage List. Except for its cultural and historical sites, Dubrovnik is inexhaustible source of traditionally prepared food, excellent selections of vine and great choice of café and souvenir shops.

DAY 5. UNESCO DUBROVNIK - KORČULA ISLAND

Continuing our cruise, we will first stop in a bay of the Elafiti Islands for swimming and sunbathing, before heading to the island of Korčula. Explore the Old Town of Korčula, which is still surrounded by its 13th-century fortifications, built by the Venetians. Korčula boasts one of the most beautiful old towns in Dalmatia and because of its fortress-like appearance it is often called "Little Dubrovnik". Overnight stay in the birthplace of the famous sailor and explorer Marco Polo.

DAY 6. KORČULA ISLAND - BRAC ISLAND

Passing the channel between the island of Korčula and the mountainous Pelješac Peninsula, we head towards the island of Brač. On our way to Brač, we will stop in one of the beautiful secluded bays of this area for swimming and sunbathing. The island landscape is dominated by a limestone relief, with numerous gullies, crevices, cavities, valleys and coves. Brač is also known for being one of the largest islands in the entire Adriatic Sea. Overnight stay in one of the lovely places in the northern part of the island, Pučišća, Postira or Supetar.





DAY 7. BRAC ISLAND - UNESCO TROGIR

We leave the island of Brač and after a swimming break in a bay on the island of Čiovo, we will return to the starting point of our journey. Visit Trogir-small picturesque town with lot of secrets situated on a lovely island by Adriatic sea. Reveal the unique memorial heritage for which it was recorded in the Register of World Heritage of UNESCO in 1997. Adore the beautiful masterpieces of famous sculptors such as the magnificent Cathedral's portal of master Radovan and the reliefs of master Niccolo di Giovanni Fiorentina.

DAY 8. DEPARTURE

After breakfast, disembarkation until 9:00 am.

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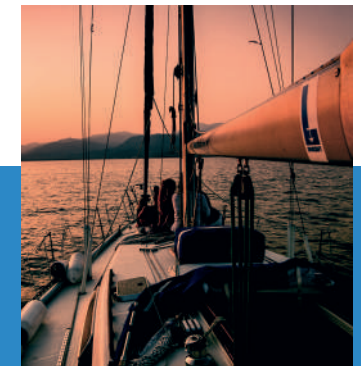
